Vintage Report 2004

The spring gave plenty of rain and sunshine producing strong healthy vine growth, but the 2004 summer was exceptionally cool. This resulted in the fruit ripening very slowly and harvest was the latest it has ever been. The vines were deliberately pruned to limit the amount of fruit grown and irrigation was minimal, resulting in a harvest of just over 1 tonne to the acre.
